As seen during the Sydney 2000 Olympics, Sydney is a friendly, multicultural city where all nationalities can feel safe and welcome.







General

General English focuses on the 4 main areas of language learning listening, reading, writing and speaking - to develop the student's confidence in the English language. Teachers develop lessons that are practical and context orientated, based on the needs and goals of the students. In the classroom, lessons focus on student interaction and involvement while teachers provide

Full-time students receive 21.5 hours of lessons. Part-time students receive 15.5 hours of lessons. Full-time students have 3.5 hours of self study.

Orientation to the school is held on the student's first day. All students are given both a written and oral placement test and, after additional instruction and a tour of the school and Manly, they begin their classes.

Students in Intermediate and Upper Intermediate levels have special interest programmes during Lesson 3 that target speaking and listening skills.

Cambridge Exam Preparation

Cambridge exam qualifications enjoy a very high level of international recognition both for further education and for employment purposes.

Depending on their level of English, students are placed into one of the three exam preparation classes:

- PET Preliminary English Test
- FCE First Certificate in English
- CAE Certificate in Advanced English

All Cambridge courses focus on real-life applications of the language consistent with the questions and focus of the Cambridge exams. Students work together in a motivated and focused classroom environment to ensure the highest results in the exams.



English for High School

This course is especially designed to prepare overseas students with the English language skills required to enter and study at an Australian high school. The course focuses on the study and cultural survival skills necessary for academic and social success at high school. In addition, students are encouraged to develop as independent and active learners of English.

The English for High School programme is a three-level course designed for the high school language learning context. Students enter the course at a level appropriate to their ability. Each level is 12 weeks in length and is based on topics which incorporate cross-curricular themes and Australian cultural elements. Individual student needs are catered for at all levels.

Teachers on the programme are qualified English as a Second Language (ESL) teachers with extensive experience in high school education. They are dedicated to providing a rewarding and motivating programme.

Curriculum for English for High School includes:

- Oral Communication & Pronunciation
- Study Skills
- · Reading and Note-taking Skills
- · Australian Culture
- Listening Skills
- · Grammar & Vocabulary

Student progress is carefully monitored and is assessed on a regular basis. School progress reports are sent to the students' guardians at the end of each 12 week course.


The reports provide detailed information on the progress of the student in each language skill, their behaviour and attendance record.

Students must achieve the equivalent of 5.5 IELTS in each of the four skills in order to graduate from the programme and commence high school. Language skills are also assessed according to the ESL scales.

English for Academic Purposes

English for Academic Purposes provides a solid foundation in the use of the English language for success in the university classroom, with a significant focus on preparation for the IELTS exam. Depending on their level of English, students are placed into either EAP1 or EAP2. Each course focuses on raising the students' overall reading, writing, speaking and listening abilities. Students also learn how to write academic essays and reports, read and research materials and successfully listen to lectures and give presentations.

EAP1 is an 8 week course, and is for students at an Upper Intermediate (IELTS 5.0 or equivalent) level. EAP2 is also an 8 week course, and is for students at a Pre-Advanced (IELTS 5.5 or equivalent) level.

All students must meet the entry requirements as specified by our partner institutions. Requirements vary depending upon the programme and institution.

- Closed groups with set start and finish dates. Classes begin every 4 weeks
- EAP1 is an Upper Intermediate Course, IELTS 5.0 equivalent
- EAP2 is a Pre-Advanced Course, IELTS 5.5 equivalent
- Admission assistance to universities, TAFE and vocational colleges

Located only 10 minutes from International House Sydney, the International College of Management, Sydney (ICMS) offers business degrees and diplomas in the popular disciplines of Hospitality Management, Internatioanl Tourism, Event Management, Retail Services Management and Property Services Management. One year Master Degrees are also available.

The ICMS qualification reflects the international nature of Business Management and provides graduates with the opportunity to both study and work in Australia and overseas.

ICMS holds a student body of over 750 and represents more than 60 different nationalities from around the globe. In association with "Cesar Ritz" colleges and Macquarie University in Sydney, ICMS has an alumni network of more than 10,000 graduates.

Diplomas are awarded by ICMS. All bachelor and master level courses are conferred by Macquarie University. Upon graduation, students receive their bachelors or masters degree from Macquarie University.

During their course, ICMS places all diploma and bachelor degree students into 38 weeks of full-time paid industry placement.








Student

At International House Sydney we believe that the happiness of a student both in and out of the classroom is important. For this reason we place great emphasis on our student services.

All of our student services staff act as **Student Counsellors** and can be approached by students if they have a problem that is not connected with their tuition. This includes areas such as accommodation, visa renewal, medical appointments and homesickness.

Our Academic Counsellors provide free advice on courses and institutions and arranges interviews and enrolment at high schools, colleges and universities. They also play an active role in the English for Academic Purposes course ensuring that students reach their study goals.

Emergency assistance is available 24 hours a day. All students are issued with a student card that carries a telephone number to contact a member of staff in case of an emergency. This gives students the security of knowing they can get help quickly at any time of the day or night.


