
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



Studying at Pacific Gateway

1. ENROLMENT

Most programs at Pacific Gateway begin every session (1 session = 4 weeks). You can register for the start of a new session according to Pacific Gateway's calendar and select your own length of study. Most students enrol at Pacific Gateway for 4-6 sessions.

2. PLACEMENT OPTIONS

At Pacific Gateway level placement is based on your ability to listen, speak, understand and respond—your ability to communicate—in English. You will be placed in one of 6 language levels: from Introductory to Advanced Plus. Your placement in these levels depends upon your placement test and intake assessment (oral interview).

3. COMMUNICATION ASSESSMENT

At the end of every session, your learning progress will be tested with the TOEIC® exam and with an oral Communication Assessment. In the Communication Assessment you will try out your new English skills in a conversation with an Australian guest.

5. NATURAL ADVANCEMENT

Most levels at Pacific Gateway have a 3-session (12 week) curriculum. You will advance to higher levels as your English ability improves. Your advancement to the next level depends upon a combination of the following factors:

- >> Student progress reports
- >> Teacher recommendations
- >> Attitude in class
- >> TOEIC® results
- >> Class participation
- >> Communication Assessment
- >> Class attendance
- >> Completion of assignments and homework

6. CHALLENGE

The Challenge is an oral examination for students who improve quickly in their class and may be ready for the next level in less than 3 sessions (12 weeks). If you demonstrate that you know the language that is taught at your current level you will be promoted to the next level!





Morning Programs

PROGRAM OPTIONS

You design your own study program at Pacific Gateway. We will try to match you to the program selected on your Application Form; however placement is on a "first come, first served" basis. Most programs at Pacific Gateway begin every 4 weeks. (Cambridge courses are scheduled to coincide with Cambridge exam administration schedules.) Students generally enrol at Pacific Gateway for 12 to 24 weeks.

^{*}You must be at a specific Level to enrol in some of these programs. Your level will be evaluated on your first day of class. (Some programs may not be offered from time to time. Be sure to check with the Brisbane campus before enroling.)

1. ENGLISH COMMUNICATION PROGRAM

The English Communication Program will help you communicate effectively in English. You will learn how to use language structures and vocabulary in real life situations.

- >> LEVELS: Introductory Advanced
- >> ENROLMENT: Every 4 session
- >> LENGTH: 1 3 sessions per level

2. TOEIC® PROGRAM

This program is designed to provide you with the strategies, practice and confidence required to improve your TOEIC® scores.

- >> LEVELS: Intermediate Upper Intermediate
- >> ENROLMENT: Every session
- >> LENGTH: 1 3 sessions
- >> TOPICS: Familiarization with the format of the TOEIC® test, test strategies, practice tests with feedback and error correction, diagnosis of weak points in English to help students learn what they need to study to improve their TOEIC® scores.



3. IELTS® & ACADEMIC PREPARATION PROGRAM

If you are planning to enter a university or college or just want to improve your IELTS® score, Pacific Gateway's IELTS® Program will help you with the skills you need to achieve your career goals. You will have the opportunity to study authentic IELTS® questions from all sections of the test and receive error feedback and explanations.

- >> LEVELS: Intermediate Advanced Plus
- >> ENROLMENT: Every session
- >> LENGTH: 1 3 sessions

Topics: Practice tests, test strategies, writing development, listening exercises and skills, grammar practice, computer lab practice using IELTS® exams.

4. CAMBRIDGE PROGRAM

The Cambridge Program will prepare you to take the Cambridge First Certificate in English Examination (FCE) or the Cambridge Advanced Certificate (CAE) or the Certificate of Proficiency in English (CPE)

- >> LEVELS: Upper Intermediate Advanced Plus
- >> LENGTH: 3 sessions
- >> CAMBRIDGE PROGRAM (FCE) START DATES: January, March & September (see calendar for dates)

5. TESL PROGRAM

If you are interested in pursuing a career in teaching English as a Second Language (TESL), Pacific Gateway's TESL Program will prepare you through course work in methodology and real classroom experience.

- >> LEVELS: Advanced Advanced Plus
- >> LENGTH: 3 sessions

6. POWER SPEAKING PROGRAM

You can add power and effectiveness to your English communication skills by taking the Power Speaking Program. This program emphasizes dynamic fluency development.

- >> LEVELS: Advanced Plus
- >> LENGTH: 1 3 sessions
- >> TOPICS: Gathering/presenting information; persuasion; problem solving; assertiveness skills training.

7. BUSINESS ENGLISH PROGRAM

Pacific Gateway's Business English Program will prepare you for a variety of business situations. This program focuses on achieving practical skills for international business.

- >> LEVELS: Intermediate Advanced
- >> ENROLMENT: Every session
- >> LENGTH: 1 3 sessions
- >> TOPICS: Working overseas; representing your company; developing business projects; business writing, presentation and negotiation skills; computer assisted research.

8. INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS SKILLS PROGRAM-ENGLISH & COMPUTERS

Through a combination of our morning ESL program, intensive Microsoft Office Specialist® studies, TOEIC® electives and optional Assertiveness Skills training, this program will help you develop practical business skills.

- >> LEVELS: Intermediate Advanced Plus
- >> LENGTH: 6 9 sessions
- >> TOPICS: Developing fluency and building interpersonal communication skills for business situations; TOEIC® and computer skills; assertiveness skills training.

After School Language Workshops and Clubs

These additional study options are offered free of charge to students after classes finish in the afternoon.

1. ACCENT REDUCTION WORKSHOP (ARW)

These small group workshops will help you improve your pronunciation by focusing on problems common of your native language group. Pacific Gateway has classes for the major language groups represented at Pacific Gateway (i.e., German, Japanese, Korean, Spanish, Mandarin, and Portuguese)

2. GRAMMAR WORKSHOP

This Grammar Workshop will help with grammar, questions and structures you have learned in your regular programs.

3. AUSTRALIAN CONVERSATION CLUB (ACC)

You are invited to join small conversation groups with Aussies from one of the local universities and Brisbane community. They are a fun way to gain confidence and improve your English conversation skills!

4. READING CLUB

You are encouraged to join the Reading Club if you would like to improve your grammar, vocabulary, and TOEIC® score while increasing your enjoyment of English literature. There is a lot of group discussion and review of reading strategies.

5. MOVIE CLUB

You can watch great films and engage in discussions with other Pacific Gateway students.


- >> Scuba diving, snorkeling, surfing lessons, and hiking through tropical rainforests


